Internal Regulations Abdijhof / Mariënkroon

Abdijhof / Mariënkroon is delighted to have you as our guest. To make your stay as pleasant as possible for you and other guests, there are a number of guidelines or rules that we ask you to take note of and follow. Mariënkroon is a site with a religious / social purpose, where individual guests and groups enjoy hospitality. Peace and respect are key words. These house rules aim to ensure a safe and pleasant stay for all guests.

- 1. Instructions given by or on behalf of authorized personnel of Marienkroon / Abdijhof must be followed.
- 2. The grounds of Mariënkroon / Abdijhof are private and are accessible only to authorized persons, namely residents, tenants and staff of Marienkroon / Abdijhof. During opening hours, visitors and walkers are welcome on the footpaths of the grounds and in the reception area, as well as visitors and volunteers from the foundations Honsoirde, Heemkunde, Gered Gereedschap, Actie creatief and the Blueberry School.
- 3. In general, use of facilities on this property, such as parking areas, bicycle racks, play facilities and walking area are at your own risk. Mariënkroon / Abdijhof cannot be held responsible for any damage resulting from the use of these facilities.
- 4 Cars and motorcycles must be parked in the parking lot. For loading and unloading, after permission of the reception, it is possible to park the car close to the entrance door.
- 5. Bicycles and mopeds can be parked in the designated racks. Please note that one of these parking spaces, directly behind the building, is exclusively for residents.
- 6. The gates on the grounds are generally closed between 20:00 and 09:00. Guests staying for several days can obtain an access pass from the reception. It is important that, after entering or leaving, the gate is closed again during this period.
- 7. In case of fire alarm, guests are required to follow the instructions posted on the room doors and act in accordance with the instructions given by staff from the emergency response team, recognizable by a yellow vest with the text BHV.
- 8. The reception is open from 10:00 to 17:00. Outside these times you can contact the emergency telephone number in urgent cases. For emergencies such as fire and accidents the phone number is 0619408565. The assembly point for evacuations is indicated on the square in front of the reception desk.
- 9. We ask you to take into account the nightly rest period on the site from 22.30 to 07.00.
- 10. In the vicinity of the chapel and conference rooms, we ask guests to be considerate of meetings taking place there, so speak softly and do not make music.
- 11. Pets are not allowed in the hotel rooms. Pets must be kept on a leash on the premises. Feces of pets must be cleaned up by the owner.
- 12. Indoors, smoking is not permitted anywhere. Outside, smoking is permitted only in designated areas.
- 13. You are welcome to consume food and beverages in the designated areas. We ask that you do not consume them in the bedrooms.
- 14. The moderate consumption of alcoholic beverages is permitted but it must not lead to inconvenience.
- 15. Open fires and barbecues on the grounds are only permitted in the designated areas in the fire pits and barbecues designated for that purpose, on the instructions of the Abdijhof staff. Care should be taken to keep these fires low and to avoid many sparks.
